VIC UPDATES JANUARY 2020

RECENT HIGHLIGHTS

- VIC conducted its quarterly board meeting on January 11, 2020 to update achievements done in 2019 and budget work plan for 2020.
- VIC signed teaming agreement with World Vision Inc (WVUS) in joining proposal to submit to USAID in response to the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) number 72044220RFA00001 on the 5 years funding project of Integrated Early Childhood Development Activity.



OVERVIEW

Veterans International Cambodia (VIC) is a non-profit humanitarian organization, founded under Cambodian law as a Local Non-Governmental Organization (LNGO). The current organization programs are to produce and distribute wheelchairs and other mobility devices to persons with disabilities (PWDs), and providing community based rehabilitation (CBR) services including awareness events, small grants for income generation, direct emergency assistances, skills training referrals, school integration support, Self-Help Groups/DPOs support for advocacy and social empowerment, as well as to provide home based rehabilitation services to children and adults with severe disabilities in targeted communities by providing physiotherapy treatment, home exercise for muscle strengthening, trained parents or caregivers on proper care, and other necessary assistances to prevent further complicated disability.

ACHIEVEMENTS (From January-December 2019)

- Produced and distributed 614 standard wheelchairs, 41 tricycles 8 walkers to 663 PWDs
- Provided 13 small grants to 13 PWDs for income generation activities
- Conducted 13 awareness campaigns and disability forums in communities
- Provided school supplies, uniforms, bicycles... to 143 Children with disabilities for education support
- Referred 8 PWDs for skill trainings
- Follow up wheelchair application to 162 PWDs and repaired 51 wheelchairs in communities
- Monitored and supported 8 DPOs and 100 SHGs in advocacy for their rights and livelihood and capacity building
- Provided home based rehabilitation (HBR) to more than 300 children and adults with severe disabilities.
